

## S4 RETRACTABLE SCREENS

Effortless Finger-Tip Operation for Wider Openings

The award-winning S4 Screen allows homeowners with large doors to enjoy the luxury of inside-outside living without the traditional compromises: insects, glare and loss of privacy. Designed to fit nearly any door, folding, french or sliding the $S 4$ delivers unparalled engineering. Operating with just a fingertip, Centor's unique load balancing technology allows screens and shades to glide smoothly across the entire opening and effortlessly stop at any desired position. When not in use, the screen or shade retracts discreetly into the frame, removing visual distractions to the view outside while also protecting it from damage, dust or dirt.

## TECHNICAL BENEFITS

- Fabrics are fully retained in the frame with no gaps to allow total control of insects, sunlight and privacy.
- Screen fabric is held securely in place by top and bottom tabs, preventing screen blow-out - even in a breeze.
- S4 can be mounted on the inside or outside - drainage holes are added to the sill for externally mounted systems.
- Sill cover is quick and easy to remove to make cleaning trouble free.


Single | A single screen that extends from one side of the frame and covers the full width of the opening, up to 181 1/2" wide.


Double | Two screens or shades (in the same fabric option), which meet at any point along the opening.


Combination | A combination of two fabric types - both covering the full width - such as a screen from the left and a shade from the right.


Corner | Two screens or shades (in the same fabric option), meet at a 90-degree angle opening for postless corner openings.

## INSECT SCREEN OPTIONS

Insect mesh is available in two different weave styles to suit varying environmental requirements.


Standard weave | Keeps insects like moths, flies and mosquitoes outside with durable polyester / PVC mesh construction. Openness: 46\%

Tight weave | Made from the same durable material but feature a smaller aperture to protect against tiny insects like midges. Openness: 37\%

Centor shades come in three forms, available in a choice of fade-resistant colors to suit any internal or external palette.
